Dear Parents and Families,

Teachers and staff have returned to school, and we are all working hard to be ready for students to return to school on September 14, whether in-person, hybrid, or remotely.

THERE ARE TWO IMPORTANT PIECES OF INFORMATION WE WANT TO YOU TO BE AWARE.

First, our STUDENT SCREENING App, GoCanvas is ready to be downloaded on your phone or computer to attest that you will screen your child/ren DAILY for COVID-19 symptoms, possible exposure to COVID-19, and/or a positive test. Each week on SUNDAY, you will need to logon to GoCanvas, attest that you will screen your child/ren daily, and answer four additional questions related to the screening. This needs to be done for ALL students enrolled, remote, hybrid, or in-person learners. You will be receiving an email with the information about how to download/access the GoCanvas application. If you are not able to access the GoCanvas App before Sunday, please send your child to school with a note saying you will screen them for:

1. They have not knowingly been in close contact days with anyone who has tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 or who has symptoms of COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
2. They have not tested positive through a diagnostic test for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
3. They have not experienced any symptoms of COVID-19, including a temperature of greater than 100.0 degrees F, sore throat, new uncontrolled cough, new onset of severe headache, vomiting, diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain in the last 14 days.
4. They have not traveled internationally or from a state with widespread community transmission of COVID-19 per the New York State Travel Advisory in the past 14 days.

Second, ALL students will be eligible to receive FREE BREAKFAST AND LUNCH EACH DAY we are in session through December 31 through a Federal Child Meal waiver.

To start the year, the first pick up for three days of meals for fully remote students and students in hybrid Cohort B will be available on Friday, September 11, from 10:00-1:00 at the side of the High School Cafeteria. Please call the High School Cafeteria, 692-8220, and leave a message with the number of students and their names you are requesting meals for. **We will need this information on Thursday by 1:00.** (Cohort A will receive meals in school).

After September 11, only FULLY REMOTE families who wish to access meals can pick them up on Wednesdays from 10:00-1:00 at the side of the High School Cafeteria. Students enrolled in hybrid Cohort A and B will have access to take-home meals as they leave on their second day of instruction.
