Dear Parent or Guardian:

New York State requires yearly physical exams when students participate in school sports. Students in upcoming grades 7th, 8th, and 9th grades at the middle school and high school are eligible for school sports physical exams.

UHS Sports Medicine physicians will be providing required sports physicals free of charge for your student-athlete at Whitney Point Central Tioghnioaga Riverside Academy on Thursday, May 10th. These sports physicals must be done if your son or daughter plans to play a sport during the 2018-2019 school year. Please find the enclosed UHS Health History form and Consent for Care that needs to be **completed and returned to the school nurse by Monday, April 30th**.

Our goal, with our partnership with UHS, is to provide your student-athlete with a comprehensive exam that includes; baseline concussion testing, functional movement screening and sports physical. UHS Sports Medicine collaborates with the Whitney Point nurses, coaches, athletic trainer and athletic department to provide exceptional care, keeping your student athlete healthy.
